•Engineer report on file from JHA

1. All reports on file. Violation noted for the month of September 2023. Total Suspended Solid and Total Suspended Solids percent reduction, each carry a \$500.00 fine.
2. Monthly Status reports remain ongoing to DEP.
3. Pump stations are in production.

•New Business

1. NEIC confirmed that a permit is needed even for a structure under 1000 square feet. GTSA will be keeping track of 2 garages that are currently being built.
2. Grant reimbursements have been submitted.
3. It is recommended that Air B&B have a rate of 1.5 or 2 EDU or be charged a commercial rate.
4. Motion to reinvest money into a 4- & 6-month T-Bills by Flynn 2<sup>nd</sup> Apostolakes. Roll call vote, all in favor.
5. Atty Coleman will set up a meeting with the person that deals with the Air B&B for Tobyhanna.

•Old Business

1. Attorney Coleman reported several liens being satisfied.
2. US vs Evans restitution has not yet been settled.

•Treasury Report

1. All monthly reports and financials were read from September.
2. The initial line of credit that was opened in August wasn't a revolving line which is what was needed. Melissa will call The Dime bank regarding either new paperwork or new loan.
3. Motion to approve check detail from August through September and Treasury report as given by Bonczkiewicz 2<sup>nd</sup> Graziano all in favor.

A. The money came from a settlement from a lawsuit GTSA vs Klepadlo.
2. Q. John Vojick asked about an 811 call, hookup for a lot he owns, and a call he made to the PUC regarding a late charge.  
A. GTSA did respond to his 811 call. He would need to pay for a line extension for a new build. GTSA is not under the PUC and can charge late fees and finance charges.
